



## West DeFuniak Elementary 2020-2021 Re-opening Plan

### 1) Arriving on Campus

- a) All staff, parents and students are encouraged to wear a mask when unable to social distance
- b) Non-essential visitors will be restricted while in Phase 2 of re-opening
- c) Students will be screened and have their temperature taken by parent prior to arriving at school. Home screening information will be located on the WCSD and WDE website.
- d) Parents are asked to keep students home if they are exhibiting symptoms attributed to COVID-19.

### 2) While on Campus

- a) A mask will be provided if a student needs one or forgot to bring one for the day. Mask are strongly encouraged, especially when social distancing is not possible.
- b) Students will not share supplies.
- c) Grab and Go breakfasts will be available as students enter the building from either car rider area or bus ramp.
- d) Lunch will be a hot meal delivered to the classroom. Students will eat lunch in their assigned classroom.
- e) Students will be able to go to recess which will be held in various designated areas on campus.
- f) PE, Art, Music and the Media Center will be cleaned between each class.
- g) Hand Sanitizer will be available in high traffic areas and in classrooms.
- h) Students will be encouraged to wash their hands or sanitize before and after transitions.
- i) Lessons will be provided on proper handwashing techniques, sanitizing, and social distancing.

### 3) Dismissal

- a) Students will be encouraged to wear a mask, as social distancing may not be possible during pick-up.
- b) Parents are asked to remain in the car during pick-up. Staff will assist students with getting in the car.

### 4) Parent – Teacher Conferences

- a) Parents may contact teachers directly through e-mail or voicemail.
- b) Conferences may be conducted by phone or virtually through Zoom or Microsoft Teams.
